2017 COLORAMA SALE

Madison, Wisconsin Friday – July 14 – 4:00 pm You are cordially invited to submit a nomination to the Colorama Sale. The process is relatively easy, and the rewards can be a pleasant way to conclude a week of showing activities.

There are a few important steps to follow if you are considering nominating an animal from your herd:

- 1. The consigned animal MUST be shown in the open show.
- 2. Consigned animals:
 - a. Must be free of all contagious diseases.
 - b. <u>Must have arrived on site with health papers completed</u> to meet interstate travel requirements.
 - c. Must be negative for TB, BRUCELLOSIS and CAE prior to the sale (testing completed prior to your arrival at the show). The animal <u>MUST</u> arrive with these tests completed prior to nomination, but <u>the animal must be listed on own health paper</u>.
- 3. Promotional information is helpful for the display board if your animal is selected, e.g., show wins, production records, appraisal information and photos of related animals. If your animal is accepted, the committee will require pictures of relatives and will take a picture of the animal to be used on the ADGA website.

Also, new this year, if you plan to nominate an animal for the sale, we would encourage you to prepare a power point with pictures of animals and relatives who may not be present at the National Show. You may simply bring these pictures on a flash drive or send them to the chair prior to the sale.

The animals that are to be Colorama Sale consignments will be selected prior to the start of the National Show. A schedule of selection process will be announced onsite.

Each animal selected for the sale will incur a \$20 nomination fee. This fee will be accessed to your ADGA account. Please review *Terms of Sale* on reverse side.

TERMS OF SALE

- 1. Owner shall furnish animal's Certificate of Registry and photos of relatives at the time consignment is accepted.
- 2. The ADGA office will send consignor payment within 30 days of sale date.
- 3. ADGA's commission fee shall be set at 15% of the sale price.
- 4. ADGA will transfer ownership of consigned animal to new owner at ADGA's expense.
- 5. After the consigned animal is sold, its health and well being become the responsibility of the buyer.
- 6. The consigned animal shall be transported at the new owner's expense.
- 7. SALE POSITIVE: The highest bidder shall be the buyer. In the event of a dispute, the auctioneer will recognize the person from whom he accepted the last bid and open the bidding to those involved. Every animal is pledged to absolute sale, unless withdrawn for just cause, and by-bidding is prohibited.
- 8. RESPONSIBILITY: The seller is the responsible party for all recommendations and warranties. The sales manager, auctioneers and sponsors are acting as agents only and are not responsible in any way, but will endeavor to protect the interest of both buyer and seller. The management is not responsible for registration certificates. The seller, or anyone associated in the sale, shall not be responsible in case of accident resulting in injury to anyone attending the sale.
- 9. WARRANTIES: The seller warrants clear title to the animal and right to sell same. Unless otherwise noted in the sale catalog or announced from the auction stand, each animal is sold as sound. Prospective bidders are cautioned to pay attention to all announcements from the auction stand.
- 10. ERRORS: A sincere effort shall be made to correct any errors noted in the catalog, but announcements from the auction stand will take precedence over printed matter in the catalog. All data in the catalog is correct to the best of our knowledge, but the sponsors and sale managers do not assume any personal responsibility for errors.
